

Past Simple

• Χρησιμοποιούμε τον Απλό Αόριστο για **ολοκληρωμένες πράξεις που έγιναν μια συγκεκριμένη στιγμή στο παρελθόν** συνήθως με τις χρονικές εκφράσεις a year ago, yesterday, last Sunday, in 2010, etc.

The first modern Olympics **took** place in Athens more than a hundred years ago.

• Για παλίες συνήθειες ή καταστάσεις.

He always caught the same train.

Long ago, they **built** most houses out of wood.

• Για να διηγηθούμε τα κυρίως γεγονότα σε μια ιστορία/γεγονός. He **kissed** her and **asked** her to marry him.

• Σχηματίζεται με την κατάληξη –ed στο τέλος του ρήματος ή αλλάζει τελείως εάν είναι irregular verb π.χ:

I **played** football yesterday. (play → play<u>ed</u>)

I **had** pizza last night. (have -→ <u>had</u>)

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I played football	Did I play football?	Yes, I did / No, I didn't
You played football	Did you play football?	Yes, I did / No, I didn't
He/she/it played football	Did he/she/it play football?	Yes, I did / No, I didn't
We played football	Did we play football?	Yes, I did / No, I didn't
They played football	Did they play football?	Yes, I did / No, I

Forms:

Affirmative: They went out last night.

Question: **Did** they **go** out last night?

Negative: They **didn't go** out last night.

(όταν έχουμε ερώτηση με το **Did** ή άρνηση με το **Didn't** τότε το ρήμα μας μπαίνει

στην κανονική του μορφή)

Time expressions: ago, yesterday, last week/month/year/night, in 1963, in November, when, the other day
